PRIVACY POLICY:

At House of Technology Company ("House of Technology", "We" or "Our"), one of our most important responsibilities is protecting our users' privacy. To that end We will not trade, sell, or disclose to any third party Your personally identifiable information without Your consent, including information derived from registration and use of any of the services available through our Sites, except as stated below. Please note that this privacy policy applies only to sites owned and operated by House of Technology, including our website, www.hotgroup.co.ke (collectively referred to herein as the "Sites").

Acceptance of these Terms:

Non-Personally Identifiable Information:

Disclosure of Aggregate Information:
